## What excites you most about your research?

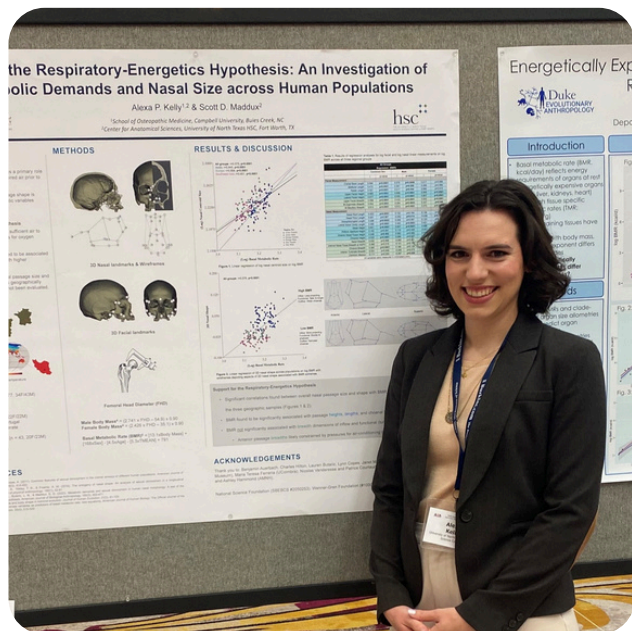
The privilege to travel around the world to various museums and universities for my research has to be the most exciting.
